<b>A</b> ct Responsibly	-Go directly to destination -Backpacks and coats remain on body	-Eyes on speaker -Observe moment of silence by turning voices off -Hands, feet, and body to self	-"Think 2" (2 pumps of soap, 2 paper towels, 2 minutes or less)	-Be at bus stop on time -Talk to "shoulder buddies" -Be ready when your bus # is called	-Take one straw and napkin -Once seated, stay seated until dismissed -Wait patiently in line	-Go directly to destination -Refrain from touching hallway displays	-Stay in designated areas -Report accidents -Line up at signal
<b>R</b> espect Self and Others	-Listen for adult instructions -Hands, feet, and body to self	-Allow personal space -Listen attentively	-Voices off -Wait calmly	-Listen to bus driver -Stay in your spot in line -Hands, feet, and body to self	-Talk to your "triangle of friends" -Talk until signaled to stop (when the last student sits down) -Say please, thank you, and excuse me	-Voices off -Allow personal space between you and the person in front of you	-Take turns -Be willing to share -Include others
